Days 1 & 2: Adelaide

Adelaide, city of churches and the capital of South Australia, is a small, elegant city boasting gracious colonial architecture surrounded by parklands. Every two years, the city hosts the internationally acclaimed Adelaide Festival. Visit attractions such as Skycity Adelaide Casino, Rundle Mall, the South Australian Museum or the seaside city of Glenelg. The National Wine Centre of Australia, historic Adelaide Oval Cricket Ground, the Bi-Centennial Conservatory and events like the Clipsal 500, WOMAdelaide and the Adelaide Fringe are just a few things to see and do. Adelaide has a laidback lifestyle and boasts amazing gourmet food and wine trails on its very doorstep

Day 3 & 4: Adelaide - Renmark 230km

Barmera is South Australia’s favourite playground and is ideally situated on the shores of Lake Bonney. The family-oriented town offers many recreational facilities accessible to visitors. From a shallow, freshwater lake, safe for swimming, popular with water-skiers, windsurfers and jet ski enthusiasts to an 18 hole golf course and lawn tennis courts. Nearby Renmark is famed for its horticulture industry and both Barmera and Renmark are gateways to explore the history and natural wonder of the famed Murray River.

Coastal Cruiser – Shortbreak

Day 1: Adelaide - Victor Harbor, 85km

Located 85km south of Adelaide, Victor Harbor is popular coastal resort and is an ideal spot for whale watching (June-Sept). Visit the fairy penguins nesting on Granite Island, which you can access via a horse-drawn tram.

Take a day tour to Kangaroo Island via ferry and marvel at one of the last unspoiled wonders of the world. Take a guided nature tour and meet the local wildlife or if you are feeling adventurous, have a go scuba diving, quad biking or sandboarding.

Day 2 & 3: Victor Harbor - Mount Gambier
