

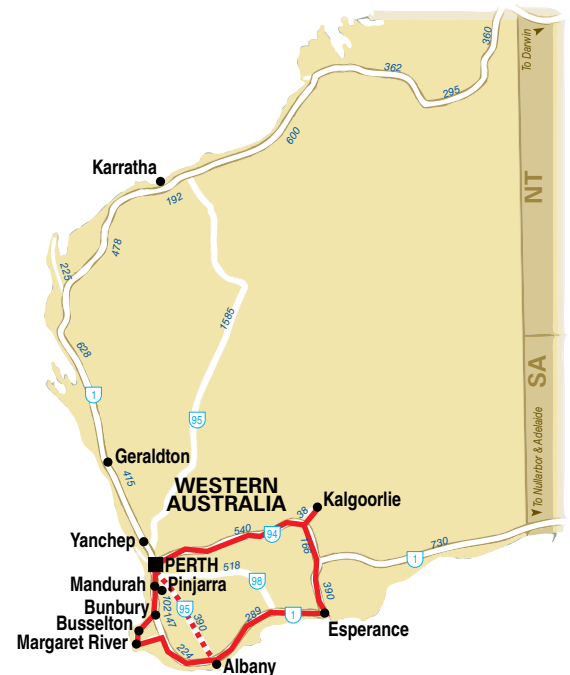
Great South West Adventurer

Days 1 & 2: Perth

Perth is a beautiful city offering an array of entertainment, cultural and culinary experiences. Visit Kings Park, cruise the Swan River, take a ferry to Rottnest Island, relax on the beach or visit the historic port of Fremantle. Just 20 minutes from the CBD is the Swan Valley. There you are surrounded by wineries, cheese factories, chocolate shops, micro-breweries, galleries, antique shops and a nougat factory. Perth has so much to do and see - so spend a couple of days exploring all there is on offer in and around Perth. Don't forget to stop by famous Scarborough Beach to soak up some sun.

Day 6: Margaret River - Albany, 380km

Day 7: Albany - Esperance, 480km

Esperance is also known for its pristine beaches, extensive National Parks and the opportunity to visit the islands that abound offshore.

Day 8: Esperance - Kalgoorlie, 400km

Kalgoorlie-Goldfields region is home to Australia’s biggest open cut mine, The Superpit, more than 360 metres deep and 3.5km long. Truly a unique part of Australia’s history and worth the visit.

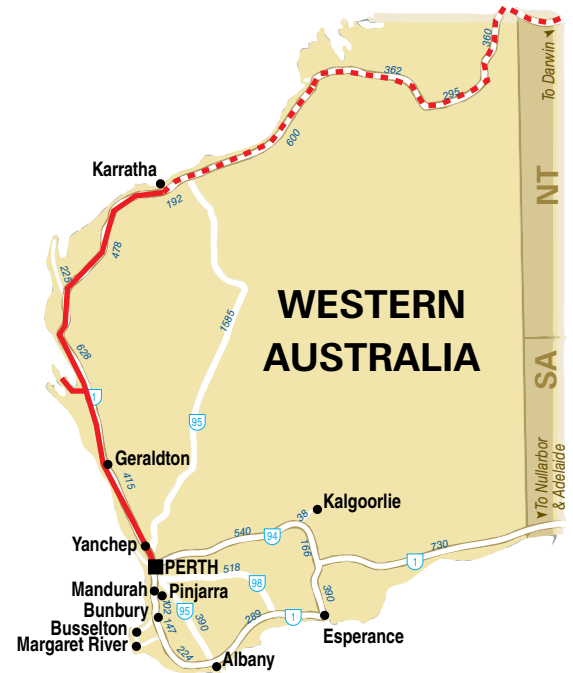

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Day 3: Perth - Yanchep, 60km

Yanchep located less than an hour north of Perth, is an ideal getaway location with pristine beaches, Sun City Country Club golf course and natural scenery just waiting to be discovered. Day 5: Geraldton - Karratha, 1112km
